 ${\rm CO_2}$ is a "greenhouse gas" which may contribute to global climate change. ${\rm SO_2}$ and ${\rm NO_X}$ released into the atmosphere react to form acid rain. Nitrogen Oxides also react to form ground level ozone, an unhealthful component of "smog".

BGE cautions against bill payment scams and utility imposters

BGE has seen an increase in reports of individuals calling BGE customers and falsely claiming their electric or gas service will be disconnected unless payment is made. Remember, BGE representatives will never call you to ask you for cash or request that you purchase a gift card or prepaid credit card to make a payment on your bill. If you have concerns about the status of your account, call BGE at

In addition, if someone states he or she is a BGE employee and asks to enter your home or business, ask for their employee information. If you are approached in person, ask to see photo identification, which should display the BGE logo, a name, photograph and identification number. Call BGE at 800.685.0123 and a representative can verify the employee and the nature of the visit or phone call.
